Course plan and its aim of this year and the following years (syllabus to be attached in a separate sheet)

The Course plan is to continue as regular course which gives credits to students at the end of examination.

We had Academic Reform recently and New Reform will start from September 2017. According to the New Reform, all courses excluding Language are to be held during one semester (12 weeks, 2-3 hours each week, 6 credits). One of the reason of this reform is to give more time to students to study for examination by decreasing the hours of class and of the credits. The Course "Asian Community in Europe" will be held on Second Semester (from March to May 2018). Therefore all lectures (12) will be on Second Semester. The Course "Asian Community in Europe" comprehends "Intensive Training" (in the form of Workshop, Seminar) and regular lectures scattered during the months of second semester (total of the lectures has to be 36 hours in order to give 6 credits).

This plan will be followed also in future years (only the name of lecturers are to be changed).
